## Wanderfull controller permissions

With this firmware version, new improvements are made for the controller's permissions. There are five main user roles: user, administrator, technician – all connected through local IP address, administrator cloud and technician cloud – connected via cloud. All of these users have different permissions and authorities in the application.

### 1. User

Every user is able to activate and run scenarios and units. The Settings tab in the application is not visible and operable. This user is not able to add or edit units, rooms, scenarios or operate the favorite units in the Dashboard.

### 2. Administrator

Unlike the user, an administrator has almost all permissions except: not being able to see and operate the network configuration, KNX and adjust the settings of the alarm.

### 3. Technician

The technician that is connected locally has all permissions in the application. For example: configuring the KNX, Bitwise, Coolmaster, network configuration and alarm (PIMA and RISCO) settings, which are all visible in the Settings tab.

### 4. Administrator (cloud)

Unlike the administrator who is locally connected, the administrator connected through cloud has different permissions. They both share the majority of permissions except: unable to delete a scenario, unit and unit group.

### 5. Technician (cloud)

The technician that is connected through cloud has all the permissions except deleting a scenario, unit and unit group.
